Desde nuestro punto de vista más que nunca, ante la constatación de que en el capitalismo se tornan imposibles las legítimas aspiraciones de la mayoría de la población, acordes a las posibilidades materiales que la productividad del trabajo permite. Porque no cunde la resignación, sino que en todos los continentes se levantan grandes movilizaciones, incluso con elementos embrionariamente revolucionarios en algunos casos. A lo largo de la historia ha habido muchas experiencias de lucha contra la dominación capitalista basada en la explotación, al menos declaradamente. En este libro analizamos diez de ellas, con distintas

Se abordan también las colectivizaciones de Cataluña de la Guerra Civil, la experiencia de Vietnam, el modelo de Kerala en India, la Revolución chilena en los primeros setenta, la cuestión de la planificación y gestión obrera en Bolivia (1952-1971) y Perú (1968-1975), además de, en el periodo reciente, la experiencia boliviana y las concesiones forestales comunitarias en Guatemala. Cada una de ellas presenta también especificidades geográficas, temporales y de nivel de desarrollo de la sociedad en la que tiene lugar, ligadas en todo caso a las relaciones de fuerza existentes, a su articulación política. Como indica el título “O inventamos o erramos”, no buscamos recetas, porque las circunstancias particulares en cada caso siempre deben ser tenidas en cuenta. Sí consideramos que el estudio de distintas experiencias arroja lecciones importantes sobre cómo se desarrollan los procesos sociales, base para intervenir en ellos con la irrenunciable aspiración final de la emancipación de la humanidad de toda forma de opresión. Esta obra tiene por objetivo contribuir, humildemente, a este fin. Post-Development from the Global South Sally Matthews, Alba Castellsagué, 2025-04-22 Post-development advocates and decolonial thinkers are calling for radical alternatives to development, but how do these ideals sit with the day-to-day reality of marginalised communities struggling with poverty, precarity, and the deprivation of human rights? This book investigates how post-development alternatives are being understood and negotiated on the ground in the Global South. Indigenous concepts and practices attributed to people in the Global South are seen by post-development thinkers as offering transformative alternatives to dominant development models of progress and economic growth. For example, buen vivir from particular regions of South America points to a ‘culture of life’ and ubuntu in Southern Africa emphasises human connectedness and mutuality. Such terms are associated with social and environmental sustainability, and a greater connection to Southern epistemologies. Drawing on extensive fieldwork, this book takes us directly to Global South communities from around the world, to consider the complex ways in which they negotiate the ideas and practices associated with (post)development, and their views on the supposed indigenous alternatives. The book encourages a contextual approach that embraces the tensions and contradictions that exist within different communities. Taking the reader from abstract post-development theory right into the heart of communities directly impacted by development, this book will be an

important guide for students, researchers and practitioners looking for better ways to address the desires and aspirations of marginalised communities in the Global South.

The Struggle for Natural Resources Carmen Soliz, Rossana Barragán, 2024-03-15 The Struggle for Natural Resources traces the troubled history of Bolivia's land and commodity disputes across five centuries, combining local, regional, national, and transnational scales. Enriched by the extractivism and commodity frontiers approaches to world history, the book treats Bolivia's political struggles over natural resources as long-term processes that outlast immediate political events. Exploration of the Bolivian case invites dialogue and comparison with other parts of the world, particularly regions and countries of the so-called Global South. The book begins by examining three Bolivian resources at the center of political dispute since the early colonial period, namely land, water, and minerals. Carmen Soliz, Rossana Barragán, and Sarah Hines show that, as in the colonial and early republican past, these resources have remained the focus of political contention to the present day. Until the end of the nineteenth century, Bolivia's battle over natural resources was primarily concentrated in the highlands and inter-Andean valleys. Beginning in the 1860s, the bicycle and soon the automobile industries triggered demand for natural rubber found in the heart of the Amazon. José Orsag analyzes the impact of this extractive economy at the turn of the twentieth century. The book concludes by examining two resources that are central to understanding the last century of Bolivia's history. Kevin Young examines the fraught business of hydrocarbons, and Thomas Grisaffi analyzes the coca/cocaine circuit. Each chapter studies the social dynamics and political conflicts that shaped the processes of extraction, exchange, and ownership of each of these resources

Nuevas estrategias de inserción internacional para América Latina Rita Giacalone, Gisela da Silva Guevara, Aldo Olano Alor, Martha Ardila, Rafael Enrique Piñeros Ayala, Graziano Palamara, 2020-08-24 El libro se interroga sobre la proyección política, diplomática, económica y comercial de América Latina y analiza las propuestas de los actores estatales, de la sociedad civil y las proposiciones de los organismos regionales. El sistema presidencial “reina” en América Latina y pese a todas las críticas que se le pueden hacer y se le hacen, no existe ninguna

posibilidad de cambiar (a corto o mediano plazo) al sistema semipresidencial, menos al parlamentario europeo. Con la finalidad de cualificar a este modelo se ha propuesto, por ejemplo, el “Semipresidencialismo” en Chile y se ha introducido el Jefe de Gabinete de Ministros en la Argentina y el Presidente del Consejo de Ministros en Perú. Como advertía Jorge Carpizo no existe una forma universal de gobierno que sea la mejor, que diferentes condiciones de desarrollo social y económico, así como político hacen que un sistema de gobierno sea más adecuado en un país que en otro, que los estudios críticos del presidencialismo tienen importancia, que existen diversos tipos de presidencialismo y que unos funcionan mejor que otros, dependiendo de una serie de factores. En todo caso, cierta bonanza y crecimiento económico son determinantes para la estabilidad del gobierno y la funcionalidad de cualquier diseño político (presidencial, parlamentario o semipresidencial). En realidad, no hay Ejecutivo débil con un Presupuesto fuerte, y musculoso porque el Presidente siempre saldrá con cierta facilidad de las “turbulencias” políticas, que son imprescindibles en todo régimen democrático.

Combining his scholarship and service in impoverished communities, the author examines the connection between poverty and health inequalities from an ethical perspective that considers contributions from different disciplines and the voices of the poor.

A Long Walk, a Gradual Ascent Nancy J. Thomas, 2019-12-05 A Long Walk, a Gradual Ascent tells the one-hundred-year story of the development of the Friends Church (INELA) among the Aymara peoples of the Bolivian Andes. It stretches from the beginnings of the INELA on the shores of Lake Titicaca around 1915 until the present time (2017), along with the story of the Oregon Friends Mission that accompanied the church for seventy-two years. Today the INELA spreads over fifteen districts with some two hundred congregations. The church is still predominately Aymara. The book considers the influence of history and culture on each phase of the church's development, exploring the complexity of planting a "peace church" such as the Quakers in a setting of so much conflict. The book also explores the missiological significance of the changing relationship between church and mission, and wrestles with denominational emphases and how they impacted the expression of an indigenous Aymara church.

Ecotourism Impacts on Indigenous Peoples Wayne A. Babchuk, Robert K. Hitchcock, 2024-11-30 Ecotourism, defined as responsible travel to natural areas that conserves the environment and improves the well-being of local people, has become one of the fastest growing industries in the world. The impacts of ecotourism on people in virtually every part of the planet are particularly true for Indigenous people. Indigenous people are found in over half of the world's countries and their cultures, customs, traditions, identities, and natural resource management systems are of great interest to scientists,

tourists, and travelers. Many Indigenous peoples reside in conservation hotspots and places with high biological biodiversity. As shown in this book, ecotourism has both promises and pitfalls for Indigenous peoples, who seek to enhance their livelihoods while conserving the habitats in which they reside and the sacredness of their traditions.
