Natürlich ging es darin zunächst um die Rechte und Pflichten der in Gilden organisierten Kaufleute, Krämer, Bäcker, Fleischer, Schuhmacher, Schmiede und Kürschner. Sie hatten das Sagen in den Städten, stellten die Ratsmitglieder und bestimmten, was ins Stadtrecht aufgenommen wurde. In Osterwieck erhielt der Richter vom verkauften Wein literweise einen Anteil. Für die Bestrafung von im Streit erzeugten Wunden wurde ein Wundpegel verwendet, um die Tiefe der Wunde nachzuweisen. Die Städte schotteten aber auch ihre Märkte ab: Außerhalb gebackenes Brot und erzeugtes Fleisch durfte nur stark eingeschränkt angeboten werden. Tuchhändler konnten Hosen verkaufen, jedoch immer mindestens sechs Stück. So florierte das einheimische Handwerk. Der vorliegende Band beschreibt diesen Prozess der immer stärkeren »Regeldichte« vom Stadtrecht über die Willküren (Stadtordnungen) bis hin zur Polizeiordnung im 18. Jahrhundert. Die Untersuchung orientiert sich hauptsächlich am Goslarer

Stadtrecht, »jener großartigen, unter den mittelalterlichen Stadtrechten Deutschlands an Umfang [...], Systematik, juristischer Durchdringung und Klarheit kaum ihresgleichen findenden Kodifikation« (Wilhelm Ebel).
