Histories of Mexico published in English usually give passing mention to his role as Minister of Public Education or his

unsuccessful campaign for the presidency, but his aesthetic system and his socio-political ideas have been ignored by philosophers in the United States. Here, for the first time, is a unified, inclusive, and occasionally critical presentation of the entire range of Vasconcelos's thought, from his metaphysics and theory of knowledge through his aesthetics and ethics to his social and political philosophy. Rousseau propone una revolución moral presidida por esquemas religiosos, aunque esta religión tiene que adaptarse a los nuevos tiempos: la metafísica debe ceder ante lo terrenal, o la moral primar frente a lo teológico. La religión civil, como religión patriótica, es expresión de su deísmo en el ámbito político.

Ambas escisiones explican la aceptación acrítica de conceptos tan difusamente delineados como "identidad autopercibida" y "sexo psicológico", protagonistas en la formulación teórica de la ideología del género. 2) El concepto queer ha fructificado en el contexto de un ambiente público que se define por: a) la maximización hedonista del placer individual; b) el enjuiciamiento de todo límite moral o institucional impuesto al deseo de satisfacción individual; y c) la brutalidad frente a todo cuanto se opone a la realización de las pretensiones individuales. 3) Mi perspectiva, que es la del Realismo Metafísico Moderado, permite impugnar el concepto "Queer", mostrando que el tratamiento hormonal y la cirugía no operan un "cambio substancial" en el individuo, sino tan sólo movimientos accidentales, casi siempre autodestructivos. Que el sujeto permanezca siendo el mismo, aunque su cuerpo se transforme radicalmente, explica el alto grado de insatisfacción entre las personas reasignadas. 4) Tanto "quiénes somos" como "lo que somos", constituye un dato objetivo y objetivable mucho antes de ser percibido por nuestra conciencia. Entender al ser humano como autoconciencia hace que desaparezca la realidad. La autoconciencia no aporta necesariamente una información veraz sobre nosotros mismos cuando se limita a ser "conciencia de sí" y no se acompaña de un ejercicio de autoexpropiación. Además, el punto de vista propiamente externo sólo se da de manera absoluta y real cuando viene moderada por la mirada ajena. 5) La ideología de género no debería constituir un contenido educativo, ya que pone su epicentro en la subjetividad, pretende una construcción arbitraria de la identidad sexual (ajena a los factores biológicos, psicológicos, sociales y culturales de la naturaleza humana), e intenta imponer una lectura de ésta radicalmente emancipada de sus estructuras teleológicas. No debe, por tanto, formar parte del currículo escolar.
