Podría pensarse que esta perfección ya se ha hallado en el paso de palio, en la proporción áurea, en los doce varales, en el oro y en la plata, en la abundancia de cera y de luces, en las flores que anuncian la regeneración primaveral, en la figuración del Paraíso, en la escenificación secuencial del triunfo del bien sobre el mal...
