Fragmentos de un discurso amoroso Roland Barthes, 2014-05-15 Sobre la trivialidad y a la vez sobre la radicalidad del amor. En palabras de Roland Barthes, este libro se vuelve necesario porque el discurso amoroso es hoy de una extrema soledad. Es un discurso tal vez hablado por miles de personas (¿quién lo sabe?), pero al que nadie sostiene; esta completamente abandonado por los lenguajes circundantes: o ignorado, o despreciado o escamecido por ellos. Asfixiado detrás del erotismo, la sexualidad, la pomografía, la publicidad, el cuidado del cuerpo y el consumo mediático. La decisión de Barthes de ocuparse del amor adquiere, en este contexto, un carácter subversivo. Publicado originalmente en 1977, es el libro más ambicioso de la última época de Barthes. ¿Pero cuál es su ambición? Darle escritura a la crítica, convertir la teoría en la gran novela del siglo XX. Un delicado relato de aprendizaje (o mejor dicho: del aprendizaje como algo imposible) sobre el deseo, el amor, la soledad, los celos y la respiración agitada. Un libro sobre las posibilidades de la crítica literaria de pensar el mundo, que para Barthes es, ante todo, discurso: Dis-cursus es, originariamente, la acción de correr aquí y allá; son las idas y venidas, andanzas, intrigas. En su cabeza, el enamorado no cesa en efecto de correr, de emprender nuevas andanzas y de intrigar contra sí mismo. Erudito y a la vez claro, transparente y complejo (como el propio amor), *Fragmentos de un discurso amoroso* es un exquisito ejercicio de semiología salvaje. Un muestrario de los lugares comunes sobre el amor y, al mismo tiempo, una formidable demolición de esos mismos lugares comunes. Construido como un vocabulario, es un tratado, no sobre el amor, sino sobre sus palabras. Sobre la locura de la sintaxis y el enamoramiento del sentido.

El discurso amoroso Roland Barthes, 2011-02 El discurso amoroso, un texto apasionante y una de las obras indispensables de Roland Barthes, reúne los documentos preparatorios e inéditos de su conocidísimo *Fragmentos de un discurso amoroso*. Cuando Barthes emprendió este proyecto el amor no estaba de moda, lo amoroso resultaba vergonzoso y el discurso sobre ello estaba condenado, si no al silencio, sí al murmullo. Barthes quiso recuperar aquello de lo que no se podía hablar; y el éxito espectacular que obtuvieron sus *Fragmentos* constituyó uno de sus logros magistrales. El discurso amoroso se elaboró en el transcurso del Seminario que Barthes impartió durante dos años en la École des hautes études en sciences sociales, de

París. Estos textos son las notas preparatorias redactadas por Barthes para dar sus clases e incorporan los pasajes suprimidos (e inéditos hasta ahora) de los Fragmentos. Esta obra es el fruto de una intensa investigación y de un cuidadoso proceso de escritura, pacientemente destilado. Su combinación de teoría y dolorosa experiencia del amor conmueve por su sinceridad y brillantez.

Historias de amor Julia Kristeva, 1987 Ser psicoanalista es saber que todas las historias acaban hablando de amor. La queja que me confían los que balbucean a mi lado siempre tiene su origen en una falta de amor presente o pasada, real o imaginaria. Y sólo puedo entenderla si yo misma me sitúo en ese punto de infinito, dolor o arrebató. Con mi desfallecimiento, el otro compone el sentido de su aventura. Nuestra sociedad no tiene ya código amoroso. En cada relato privado, íntimo, inconfesable, buscamos descifrar los meandros de ese mal que tiene una relación tan extraña con las palabras. Idealización, estremecimiento, exaltación, pasión; deseo de fusión, de catástrofe mortal tendida hacia la inmortalidad, el amor es la figura de las contradicciones insolubles, el laboratorio de nuestro destino. ¿Filosofía, religión, poesía, novela? Historias de amor, de Platón a santo Tomás, de Romeo y Julieta a Don Juan, de los trovadores a Stendhal, de la madona de Baudelaire a Bataille. Las grandes elaboraciones simbólicas no dicen nada que no se escuche en la sombra, cada día. Estar psíquicamente en vida significa estar enamorado, en análisis o presa de la literatura. Como si toda la historia humana no fuera más que una inmensa y permanente transferencia.

El léxico del autor Roland Barthes, 2023-06-01 Escribir sobre lo que he escrito es manifestar fatalmente que estoy condenado a mis propios límites, es hacer públicos esos límites, es asumir una tautología (yo soy soy): pero yo odio la tautología, figura del discurso de la doxa. ¿Un libro mío sobre mis escritos? Imposibilidad reglamentaria de que sea un libro “trascendente”: nunca será otra cosa que un libro más, igual, homogéneo respecto de los demás (esto que, al principio, puede ser sentido como un fracaso, será en realidad la salida de lo Imaginario). En 1972, Roland Barthes recibe una propuesta editorial perturbadora: escribir un libro sobre sí mismo, un ensayo de autocrítica que relea treinta años dedicados a pensar su gran aporte a la French Theory: la escritura. Barthes asume el compromiso, pero el honor que acepta un poco infatuado se convierte muy pronto en un proyecto inasible, problemático, que lo inspira como nunca pero lo fastidia también. Con el libro recién bocetado, Barthes duplica la apuesta y transforma el proyecto de libro en el tema de su célebre Seminario de la École pratique des hautes études de 1973-1974. El léxico del autor es el registro de esa experiencia inaudita, que Barthes comparte con una quincena de estudiantes y que poco después desembocará en Roland Barthes por Roland Barthes, verdadero libro-bisagra en su trayectoria. A lo largo del curso, Barthes piensa su libro en voz alta, pone a prueba ideas e hipótesis, discute sus entusiasmos y sus vacilaciones. Como el libro es una extraña versión de autobiografía intelectual, no es solo su pensamiento o su escritura lo que expone; es él mismo, su imaginario de escritor, su intimidad, su cuerpo, sus fantasmas. Así, El léxico del autor es al mismo tiempo la crónica grupal de un libro que se escribe en vivo, el experimento de una introspección a cielo abierto y el ensayo de un modelo de enseñanza utópico, fundado en el deseo y la diferencia, donde

el Maestro no trasmite otra cosa que el sinuoso work in progress de su práctica y lo que se enseña, en el fondo, no es lo que se repite sino lo que solo sucede una vez. Alan Pauls
